Contextual Summary

This is a post-visit English resource that engages students with their visit to Robin Hill Country Park.

This will need to be investigated alongside 'normal' guide books so that pupils are immersed in high-quality examples of persuasive writing; (the Red Funnel website www. redfunnel.com offers further examples of tourist attraction writing in addition to the ones listed on the lesson plan).
