Students will need to consider the audience and purpose of their writing, and draw upon their knowledge of the features of their chosen genre. Skills of planning, drafting, evaluating and editing their work will be encouraged throughout the writing process, allowing students the opportunity to think aloud to generate ideas and check that meaning is clear.
